***RV: Reduction Value**

- ***Reduction Value Concept:** In order to give more importance/weight to the performance in the current year, there will be a points devaluation over a period of 3 years (100%, 70%, 40%). For example, in 2010 the points value of this year and the past one will be:
 - **2010: 100%**
 - **2009: 70%**
 - **2008: 40%**
